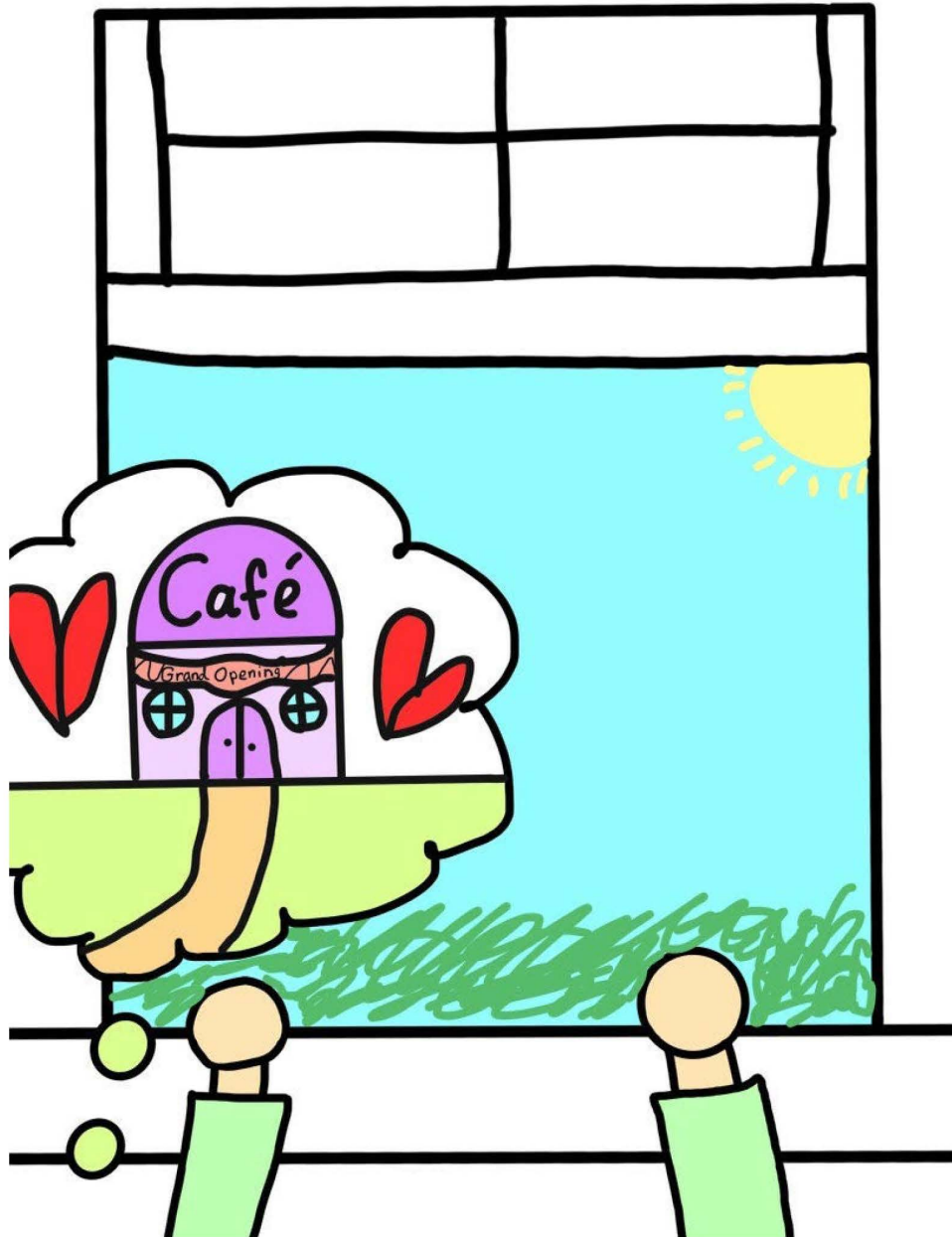


What I Want to be When I Grow up

When I look out the window, I daydream about owning my own café when I grow up.



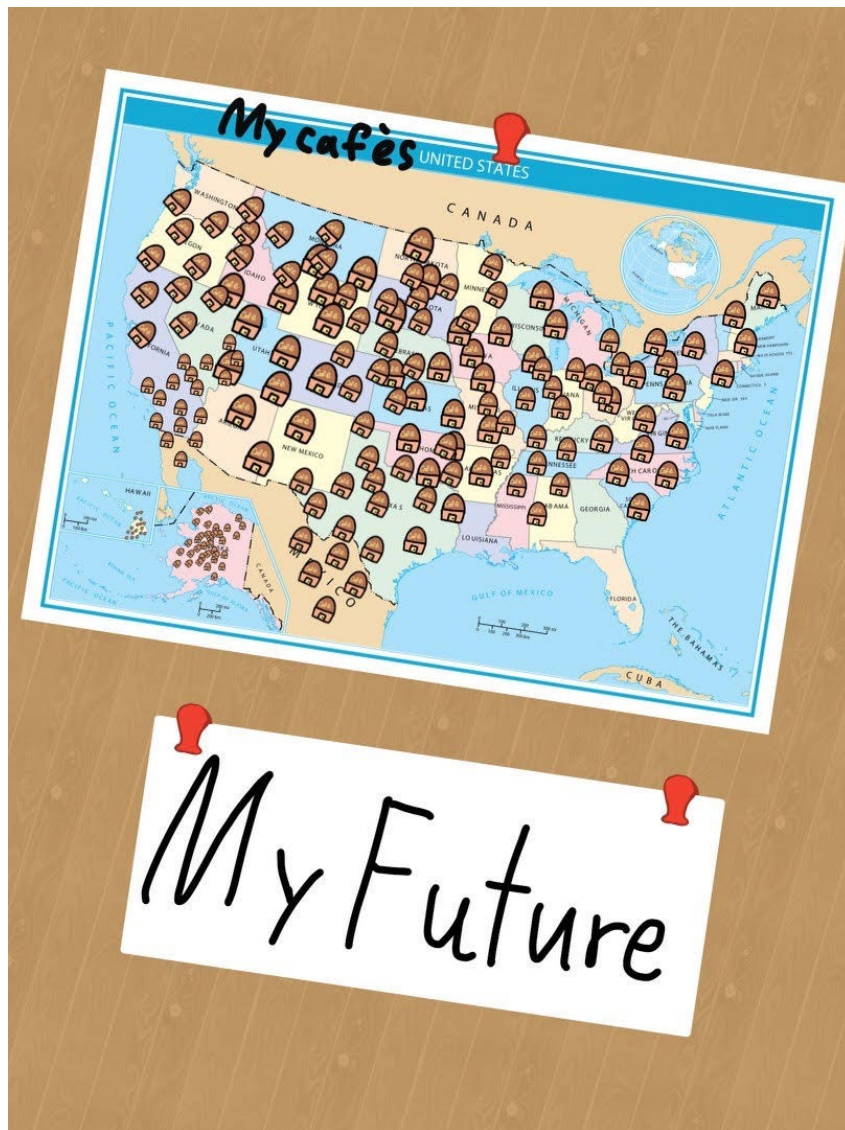

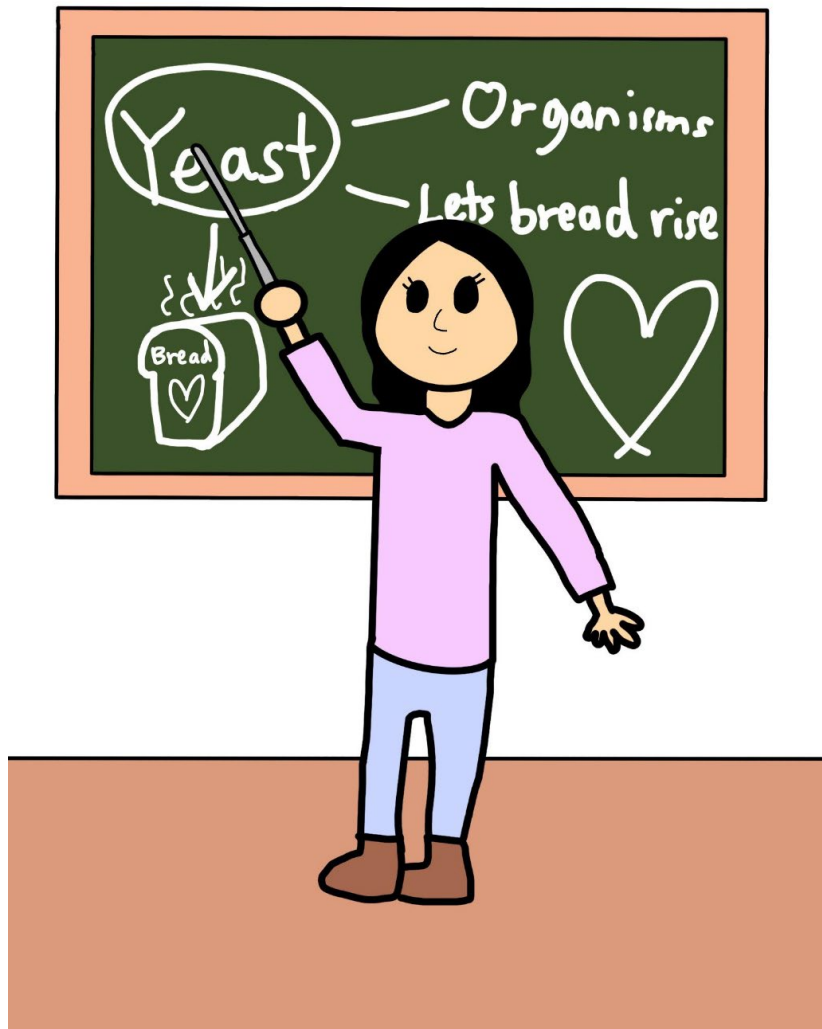
